Tips for completing the Danville Area Sustainable Business Checklist

The following suggestions have been prepared to assist applicants with the completion of the checklist and to provide a partial list of sites that can serve as a ready reference of additional information for adopting sustainable practices.

Initially, read over the checklist to gain an understanding of the variety of measures covered. Read each measure and check off those that you confidently feel your business has been accomplished. Next, identify those measures that might have been satisfied or are partially satisfied. The remaining measures should be the ones that need to be considered or completed subsequently. Keep in mind that these business measures may not specifically pertain to your type of business. Make sure that all measures that have been satisfied have been checked off.

Now it's time to count all the "for sure" boxes that have been checked, including the number of specifically required items indicated in each of the six general activity areas : (Solid Waste Reduction, Water Conservation, etc.).

If you have reached the minimum number of twenty-five (25) measures satisfied, then you are eligible to be recognized as a "Danville Area Sustainable Business".
